VACANT LAND SALE UPDATE

The Board of Directors, with the approval of the 7/11/21 Congregational Voter's Meeting, and with the help of the Faith, Ledyard & Faith law firm, finalized and signed a Purchase and Sale Agreement with Porter Kyle for the Church's vacant land. The title company is working through its process and an escrow account has been established. An environmental assessment of the property is expected to be done soon.
