This Men's Group is designed to form Christian friendships, and to study the Lutheran Confessions (the Book of Concord).

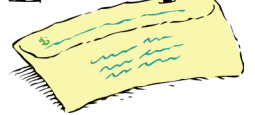
Women's Monday Night Bible Study

Rev. Dr. Adam Koontz is Assistant Professor of New Testament Theology and Director of Field Education at Concordia Theological Seminary, Fort Wayne. Prior to being called to the seminary, he served as Pastor at Mt. Calvary Lutheran Church in Lititz, PA where he planted Concordia Lutheran Mission in Myerstown, PA. He received his PhD in Religion from Temple University in Philadelphia, PA with a focus in Paul and the Early Church. He regularly presents on a number of topics including Evangelism, Practical Theology, Cultural Issues, and Paul. Some of his recent presentations include Motivation for Mission in Romans, A Cultural Forever War: Western Civilization Against the New Barbarians, Against the Stream: Paul's Missionary Gospel in Hard Times. He is a frequent guest on podcasts such as Word Fily Spoken, A Brief History of Power, and Issues, Etc.
