Why go to the Lord's Supper?

But those who are mindful of their weakness desire to be rid of it and long for help. They should regard and use the Sacrament just like a precious antidote against the poison that they have in them. Here in the Sacrament you are to receive from the lips of Christ forgiveness of sin. It contains and brings with it God's grace and the Spirit with all His gifts, protection, shelter, and power against death and the devil and all misfortune. So you have, from God, both the command and the promise of the Lord Jesus Christ. Besides this, from yourself, you have your own distress, which is around your neck. Because of your distress this command, invitation, and promise are given. This ought to move you. For Christ Himself says, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick" [Matthew 9:12]. In other words, He means those who are weary and heavy-laden with their sins, with the fear of death, temptations of the flesh, and of the devil. If, therefore, you are heavy laden and feel your weakness, then go joyfully to this Sacrament and receive refreshment, comfort, and strength [Matthew 11:28].


Portals of Prayer

Symbols of Salvation

An Interactive Youth Christmas Program in "the Round"

Ordinarily, when we think of Old Testament prophecies of the birth of Christ, we have in mind specific verses. These direct prophecies point clearly to the coming of Jesus as the Savior Messiah. But in addition to these wonderful verses, Jesus teaches us that, in fact, the entire Old Testament prophesies about Him. All of the Bible is about Jesus. From the very beginning of creation, the ways God interacts with His people give us living symbols that foreshadow and foretell Jesus' advent among us in the flesh.

On **December 11th at 6:30pm**, our Trinity Children & Youth will tell about Jesus' birth using common Christmas symbols like evergreen trees — one completely dark with red glass balls (hmmm, what's that about?), paper mangers, and an angel, of course, with joyful hearts, songs, and readings.

Father in heaven, thank You for sending Your Son for our salvation. Give us eyes to see the symbols of Christmas that point us to the Savior. Fill us with Your Spirit, so that we may joyfully proclaim the Good News of Jesus' birth to all those around us. In His name, we pray. Amen.
