The annual meeting of the Congregational Assembly is scheduled for June 5, 2022 in the Sanctuary at 12:45 p.m.

The Board of Directors will be asking for the adoption of the 2022/23 fiscal year budget, election of Officers, Elders, & Endowment Committee Members, and a change to the Constitution & Bylaws. Comments from the Synod have already been incorporated into the Constitution & Bylaws, but one final change is being proposed that we need to address. This change will allow the Board of Directors to Call commissioned ministerial workers (i.e. teachers). 
Phones, iPads and Laptops
