

LAND SALE UPDATE

Trinity's sale of 7.4 acres of vacant land to Porter Kyle is completed. The Purchase and Sales Agreement was signed on September 7, 2021 at an agreed price of \$373,000 per acre and closed on May 9, 2024.

The Lutheran Church Extension Fund (LCEF) will receive \$2 million to pay down the mortgage and, after all the fees & expenses are paid, the Church will receive \$537,758. We thank the Lord for our Congregation and the LCEF organization. It is by God's grace alone that we are able to have a beautiful place to worship, learn, and serve Him!

UNDERSTANDING THE ABSOLUTION

Sometimes visitors in a Lutheran service of worship are surprised to hear in the general confession and absolution our pastors saying: "Upon this your confession, I, as a called and ordained servant of the Word, announce the grace of God to all of you and in the stead and by the command of my Lord Jesus Christ I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." Our Lutheran Confessions help us to understand why our pastors speak this way: "It is not the voice or word of the man who speaks it, but it is the Word of God, who forgives sin, for it is spoken in God's stead and by God's command" (AC XXV.3).

Absolution is the Lord's life-giving, sure and certain word that does for us what no surgery, medicine, therapy, counseling, or advice can do for us. The Lord's Word of Absolution doesn't cover up or hide our sin. Nor does it give us only a temporary relief that soon fades away. Our Lord's word of absolution reconciles us to God the Holy Trinity.

Praying for the good Lord to lead us! Looking forward to seeing how He will supply!


Please pray for God to send us more workers in our corner of His kingdom!
