## Yambio, South Sudan!

Yambio is the village where the Concordia Lutheran Institute for the Holy Ministry (CLIHM) is located. CLIHM is the seminary of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of South Sudan/ Sudan. It is basically several block wall constructed buildings with tin roofs. There are 24 students from all over South Sudan and southern Sudan who are in their first of four years studying to be



pastors. They are making incredible sacrifices for their studies. On July 16, Pastor Bolte leaves to help train these men: he will be introducing them to Theology and Scriptures; with emphases on Christ, Grace, Holy Trinity, and Creation.



## BACK TO SOUTH SUDAN! Pre-Trip Update from Pastor Bolte

The Lutheran Heritage Foundation (LHF) was instrumental in starting the Evangelical Lutheran Church in South Sudan. What began with a handful of Luther's Small Catechisms has now led to a rapidly growing Church body in South Sudan, Sudan, and multiple refugee camps in various countries. The LHF translates, publishes, distributes and introduces books that are Bible-based. Christ-centered and Reformation-driven. In more than 80 countries and 100 languages, thousands of people have come to faith in Christ because they've been able to read books like The Good News About Jesus or Luther's Small Catechism in their own languages. LHF has published the catechism in more than 90 languages with dozens more requested. In the past decade. LHF has published and distributed over 1,000 titles and 3 million Lutheran books to pastors, seminary students, missionaries and churches – all at no cost to them. The LHF is a worthwhile, conservative Lutheran cause that is making disciples!





- a survey of the property has been completed
- the Site Plan & Design Review Planning Application has been filed with the City of Avondale Additionally, there have been conversations with the City of Avondale and it looks like there will be a left turn in from Indian School Road onto Plaza Circle. The left turn in from Dysart Road may not happen, but is still under discussion.

she will add your name to the list. Going forward, everyone please send your request to Jan at the above email address.




### **Friday Parenting Group**
