

### LAND SALE UPDATE

Trinity's sale of 7.4 acres of vacant land to **Porter Kyle is completed.** The Purchase and Sales Agreement was signed on September 7, 2021 at an agreed price of \$373,000 per acre and closed on May 9, 2024. The Lutheran Church Extension Fund (LCEF) will receive \$2 million to pay down the mortgage and, after all the fees & expenses are paid, the Church will receive \$537,758. We thank the Lord for our Congregation and the LCEF organization. It is by God's grace alone that we are able to have a beautiful place to worship, learn, and serve Him!




